## This Week at CLS

It's almost spring break, but first K-8 and their teachers formed a Reading Train--reading silently in the gym for 15 minutes--for Monday's Read Across America Day/Dr. Seuss's Birthday, and Pre-K-8 students, staff and lots of parent volunteers lovingly made 500 sandwiches on Friday for The Sandwich Project! And meanwhile, down the hall...

**Pre-K** learned how Jesus fed more than 5000 people with His heavenly power and remembered His loving example as they made sandwiches for the homeless!

Each **kindergartener** did research on an animal, reading for details on what they look like, what they eat and where they live!

**First grade** studied animal habitats and created a diorama of an animal's habitat!

**Second graders** read nature poems, learned about food chains and enjoyed seeing everyone reading in the gym!

**Grades 3/4** had fun with pickleball and singing "John Jacob Jingleheimer Schmidt" with different tempos and dynamics, but not so much fun with mixed numbers and measurement!

**Fifth graders** looked at the Third Article, multiplied fractions and sang the alto line in parallel thirds!

**Sixth graders** discussed the meaning of prayer, plotted on grids, studied adverbs and also sang alto!
