- Who is noticeably absent from signing on to the new legislation and in what way was it presented to the king? vv.6-9.

Read Daniel 6:10-15.

- What was Daniel's response to the new legislation that ordered him to pray only to or through King Darius?
- What was the king's response to the unalterable edict he had made when he found out Daniel had broken it? (v.14)

Read Daniel 6:16-28.

- Discuss how Daniel stood firm in the LORD during this whole episode.
- Discuss the ironies of a frantic king trying to save Daniel and God actually doing it.
- In what ways did God use Daniel and Darius for his glory and his kingdom?

Application:

- * Share any incident when you were "put on the stand" to stand firm in God's truth and how it turned out.
- * What kind of forces in government or culture in our country are persecuting God's people today? Who's *really* behind it?
